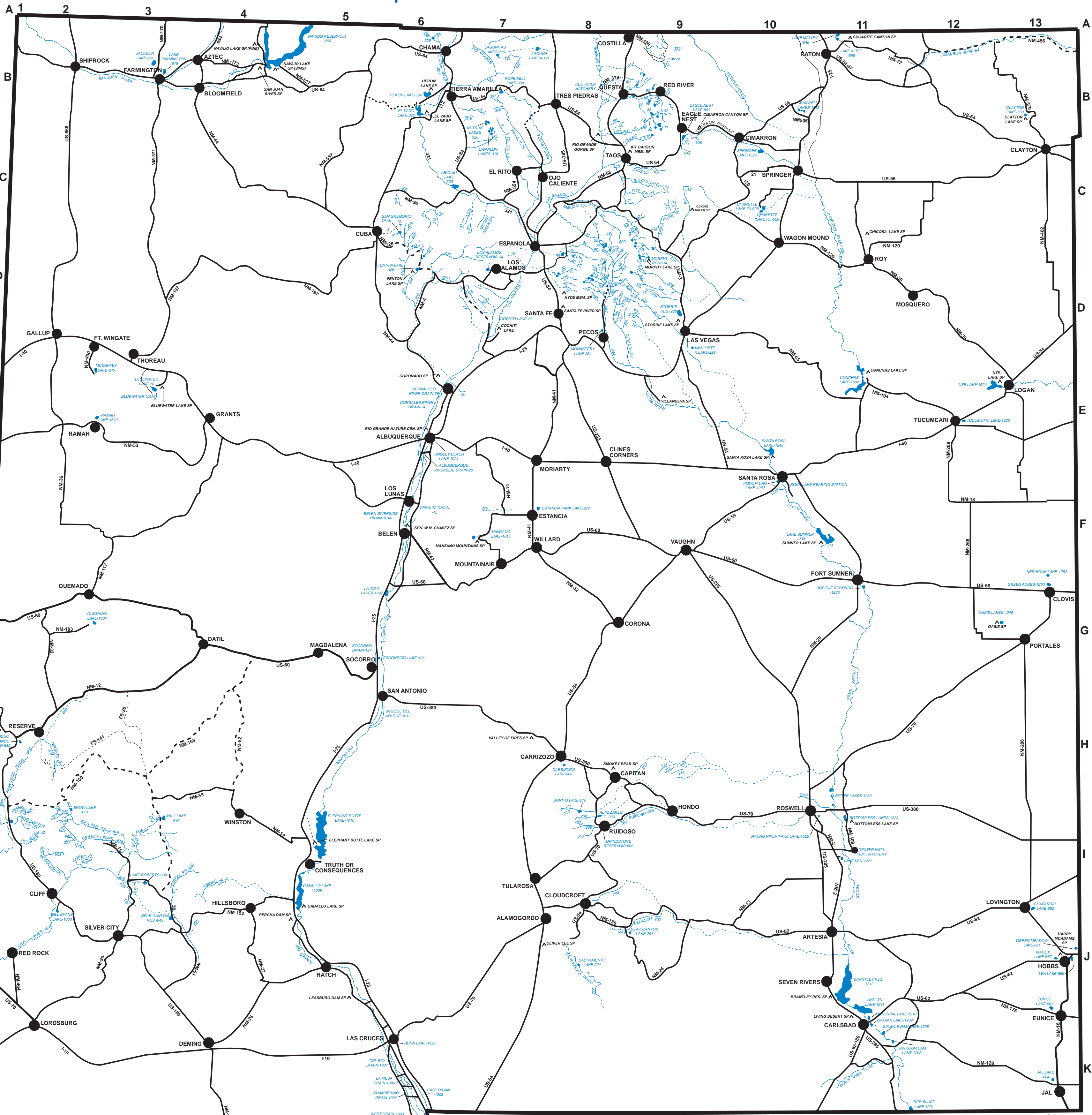


NEW MEXICO public FISHING WATERS MAP

NOTE: Water numbers 1-700 are generally trout waters, with some exceptions. Higher numbers, 1,000-1,700 are generally warm-water fisheries. However, some lakes and streams contain trout and warm-water species both, and others are stocked with trout when winter water temperatures permit. Check the alphabetical listing on the reverse for a description, and your current fishing proclamation for details.
